### Color 101: Color Basics for Quilters

Don't be fooled by other color classes, Eda's is the *original* Color 101. Designed for those who have little or no experience in classic color theory, this 10 session workshop has been designed to give quilters a basic, yet in-depth working knowledge of the color wheel and color relationships. In each session, a specific color combination will be discussed and concepts important to quilters, such as the value, depth, texture and scale of fabric, as well as other essential color effects will also be addressed. The workshop project is a 9 block quilt, made as classes proceed.

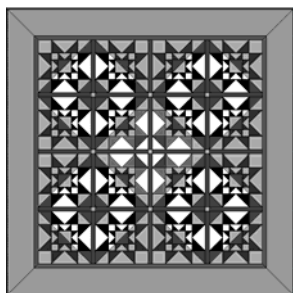
