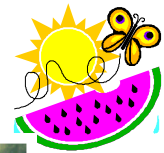


# Summertime at Quilter's Crossing 2006 July-August-September



Dear Friends,

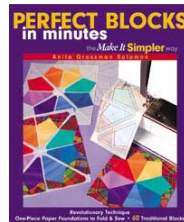
